



### What We Do

- Reading Assist provides year-round highdosage tutoring services to children with the most significant reading challenges, prioritizing support to low-income students, students of color, and multilingual learners.
- We recruit and train AmeriCorps members, known as Reading Assist Fellows, to work 1:1 and in small groups 3–5 times per week with struggling readers.
- We provide additional support to students through our summer and after-school programs.
- We offer training and certification to teachers, reading specialists, and other educators who wish to increase their understanding and knowledge of the science of reading.

82% of children from low-income households lack reading proficiency by 3rd grade 74% of struggling readers won't catch up after 3rd grade
