For 35 years, Reading Assist has supported struggling readers through our accredited structured literacy program, which is rooted in the science of reading. We consistently help students achieve reading success.

High-Impact Tutoring

Our tutors work 30-40 minutes daily with students in need of intensive reading support.

Summer/After-School

Our tutors are embedded in summer and after-school programs to help reduce learning loss for students.

Coaching Model

We help schools build capacity to support students using their own teaching staff.

Professional Development

We help schools improve student reading skills at even higher rates through specialized training for educators.



Each year Reading Assist recruits and trains tutors in our accredited training program to serve struggling readers. School-year tutors enroll as AmeriCorps members, providing tutoring in service to their communities. Tutors come from a broad range of backgrounds and experiences.

Building Teacher Pipelines

Tutors to Teachers Delaware—In partnership with Wilmington University, our tutors can serve with Reading Assist and earn a master's degree in special education in two years for as little as \$4,000.

Teacher Pathways–Reading Assist engages high school seniors in education pathway programs as tutors, providing a stipend and AmeriCorps education award while helping them build connections with future employers.
