Directions for **Silent e BINGO**



GAME PREPARATION AND MATERIALS:

- Print the BINGO game cards (pages 2 to 5) on card stock. Place each BINGO card in a plastic sleeve or laminate before use.
- Print word cards (page 6) on card stock, laminate (optional)., and cut out word cards.
- Dry erase markers and a dry eraser.

GAME PLAY:

- Each player chooses a BINGO card.
- The center Reading Assist tile is a FREE space!
- Teacher or student picks and reads word card.
- Student marks word on their BINGO card with dry erase marker.

 The first player to get five across, down or diagonal (BINGO) wins.

GO FISH:

• Players try to match words. Example: "Do you have "plane"? If the other player has the word, they give it up. First player reads the two cards ("plan" and "plane") and keeps the pair. If player two does not have "plane", they say "Go Fish". Player one picks from the deck. Determine before playing if players only pick one card, or keep picking until they have a match. First player to either use all their cards, or have the most pairs, wins.
