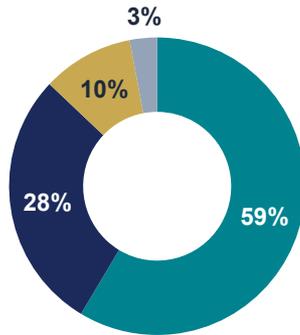

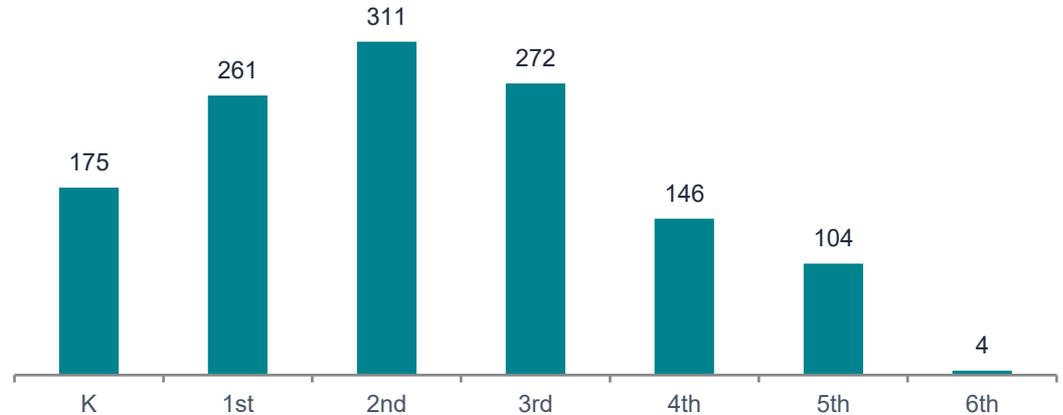

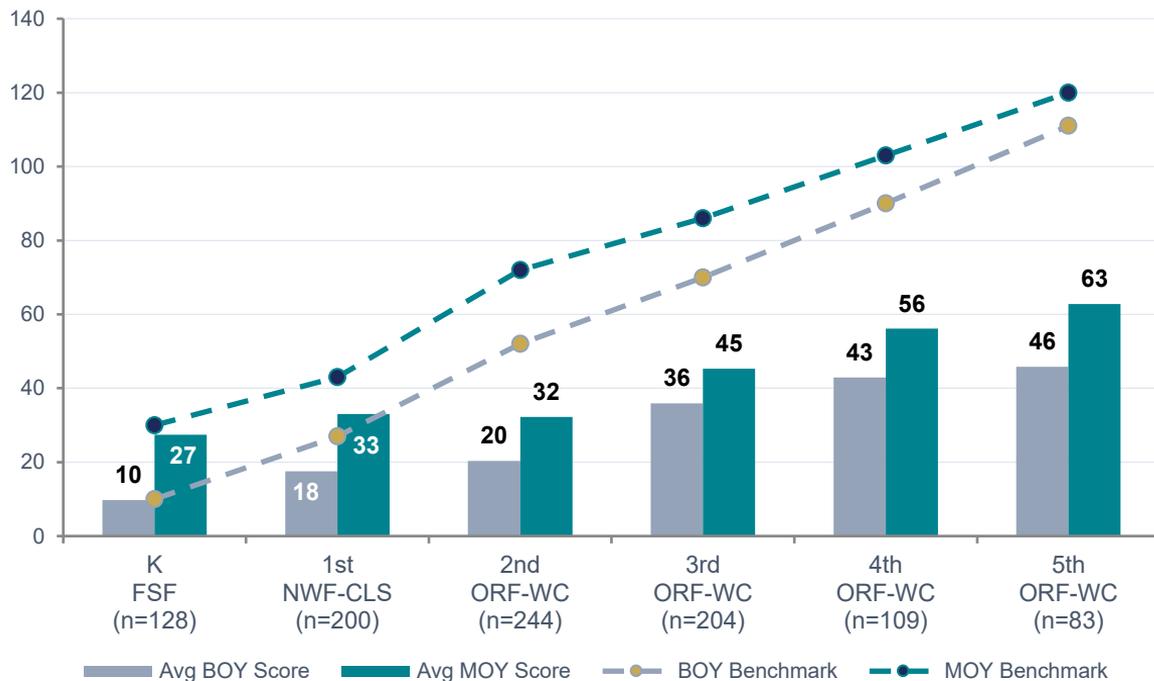

Beginning to Mid-Year Growth by Grade

Average Primary Measure Scores vs. Benchmark (students with beginning and mid-year data)

Grade	BOY	MOY	Δ
K	97%	91%	-6%
1st	65%	77%	+12%
2nd	39%	45%	+6%
3rd	51%	53%	+1%
4th	48%	54%	+7%
5th	41%	52%	+11%



5 of 6 grades are closing the gap toward benchmark on their primary measure. K students are near benchmark already (91% at mid-year).

Green (Δ+) = closing gap **Orange (Δ-)** = gap widening
