




Summer 2022 Student Numbers

77 Reading Assist Tutors worked with 537 students from 20 schools in four districts, including 4 charter schools and 4 camps, during summer 2022.

344 students were tested at either the program's beginning, its end, or both. Data in this report represent this group of students.


Students were assessed in three Acadience measures:

- 1. Phoneme Segmentation Fluency (PSF)
- Nonsense Word Fluency Correct Letter Sounds (NWF-CLS)
- Nonsense Word Fluency Whole Words Read (NWF-WWR)

Student Reading Growth

87% of students tested at both beginning and end grew in at least one measure.

As a whole, students grew in three out of three early and intermediate reading skills.



Student Reading Growth by Grade Highlights










