86% of Reading Assist Students Show Improvement

This summer, for the first time ever, Reading Assist extended its daily, high-dosage tutoring program to almost **500 struggling readers across Delaware**. After just four and a half weeks of reading intervention, students made incredible gains, with 86% showing growth.

Reading Assist recruited, trained, and embedded **75 tutors to work one-on-one with students** in **15 schools** as part of the Delaware Department of Education's spring 2021 Strategy to Accelerate Learning - an initiative designed to address unfinished teaching and learning as a result of the pandemic.



Like students across the country, many Delaware students experienced a disruption to their learning spanning more than a year. Recognizing the severity of children's learning loss, Reading Assist was eager to expand its services to help students who desperately needed live instruction. When the Department of Education approached us in February 2021 to explore ways we could extend our program to reach children over the summer, we quickly adapted our school-year program and helped schools set up capacity to provide summer tutoring.


